The Town of Sandyfield is soliciting qualifications from experienced and qualified firms to provide professional engineering services related to the Town's Public Drinking Water Infrastructure in support of the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Rural Development Special Evaluation Assistance for Rural Communities and Households (SEARCH) Grant Program and potential future funding for implementation of the proposed water meter replacement project. The Town is planning to replace approximately 165 existing water meters within its water service area.
